## Learning-At-Home Quick Facts:

Dear Parents:

It is very important that you take the time to read through this document to familiarize yourself with the expectations for your child while they engage in learning at home.

***\*\*If your child's homeroom teacher is notified by 12:00 pm they will be able to set your child up for learning at home for the next day. Any notifications after that will require the next full school day to set your child up.***

### Important Information:

- Your child should be in their school uniform when participating in our Learning-At-Home program.
- Your child should be present on Zoom, ready to begin their day at 8:30 a.m. Their interaction with synchronous learning (learning in real time) will be guided by their homeroom teacher and specialist teachers throughout the day. Therefore, times for being off Zoom will be directed by their teacher.
- On Zoom your child will be able to interact with their teachers and classmates in sharing their ideas and asking questions to respond to their learning throughout the school day.
- For the most part, your child will be following the daily timetable for their class, however, it is important to bear in mind that flexibility may be needed according to the professional judgement of their teacher.
- Provide support, as needed, with technology and materials. As parents you may need to download any PDF materials needed for your child's work in classes on Zoom, or gathering much needed materials. If you have any problems with the technology during a synchronous learning time on Zoom, please try to avoid interrupting the teacher during a lesson and allow teachers the time to follow-up with you once the lesson has been given.
- Please help your child post their finished work as directed by the teacher on Seesaw in the correct folder so it can be assessed accordingly (i.e. artwork posted in the art folder).
- Leave the work to your child, and let them submit whatever they have accomplished. It is imperative to the assessment process and your child's progress that his/her teachers see their successes as well as mistakes and challenges. If his/her teachers don't see the areas for growth they will not be able to help your child in achieving their personal best.
- Knowing that your child will be assessed on grade level outcomes in all subjects/areas, it is important that they participate in the specialist classes as well. (i.e. art, drama, physed, French music, outdoor education)
